Case Farms Donates \$20,000 To Morganton Community House Project

MORGANTON, N.C. — **April 17, 2015**— Case Farms, a leading poultry producer, has recently pledged to donate \$20,000 over the next three years to the City of Morganton's Community House Project. This annual donation will be used to renovate the Community House located at 120 N. King Street in downtown Morganton.

Throughout the next three years, the City of Morganton will allocate Case Farms' donation to the renovation of the Community House lobby, including new restrooms that will meet code and an elevator that will provide handicap access to smaller meeting rooms. Funds will also be allocated to update the Cobb Room. Renovations include tray ceilings, chandeliers and new flooring.

"This will be a major renovation that will be used by the Morganton community for years to come. We are grateful to receive Case Farms donation as they have set the bar high for other industry leaders in Morganton," adds Cohen.

The Community House was built in 1935 with the original purpose of providing a venue for clubs, civic groups and citizens of Morganton. In January, the Morganton City Council approved making more than \$450,000 worth of upgrades to the Community House infrastructure, taking the first steps in a public/private renovation project to overhaul the facility to meet the needs and expectations of Burke County-Morganton residents.

"The Community House is a venue we utilize regularly for corporate meetings and company banquets," said Hector Velez, Case Farms human resources manager in Morganton. "When we heard the City of Morganton had plans to renovate the Community House, we were more than happy to provide financial support to the project. We are thrilled to see the renovations unfold over the course of the next three years."
