Purpose

Case Farms desires to offer work/learning opportunities to college students currently enrolled in Accounting study programs. Who is Eligible?

To be considered for an Accounting internship position, a student must:

- Be able to work 30-40 hours per week in Case Farms' Corporate Office (Troutman, NC) during May – August 2010 (flexible based on school semesters ending and beginning).

How Does a Student Apply for an Internship?

1. Complete the Accounting Internship application.
 - Résumé is not acceptable in place of the application, but is allowed as a supplement.
2. Provide current college transcript reflecting courses taken and grades received.
3. Submit application no later than April 16, 2010.
