North Carolina Department of Labor Honors Case Farms at 62nd Annual State Safety Awards
Case Farms Goldsboro division receives Gold Award for second consecutive year

Goldsboro, N.C. (May 6, 2019) – For the second consecutive year, fully-integrated poultry farming and processing group [Case Farms](http://www.casefarms.com) has won the Gold Award from the North Carolina Department of Labor (NCDOL) for its safety record. Awards were presented by North Carolina Commissioner of Labor Cherie Berry on May 2nd at the Lane Tree Country Club.

The Goldsboro division received the state’s highest safety award in recognition of its outstanding on-the-job safety and health efforts and the promotion of safe working conditions, and falls on the heels of the division’s recent [one million hours safety milestone](#). The gold award is based on a days away, restricted or transferred (DART) rate that is at least 50 percent below the statewide rate for the industry.

The annual awards program, run by the NCDOL and hosted by the Wayne County Chamber of Commerce, recognizes private and public companies that achieve and maintain a high level of safety. In order to qualify, each company must have had no fatalities during the calendar year at the site or location for which the award was given and must have maintained an incidence rate of at least 50 percent below the average for its particular industry group.
