Information for Students

Case Farms' Scholarship honors the legacy of a good friend and integral member of our family, J. Leroy Cook. Leroy helped Tom Shelton build Case Farms since our inception in 1987. He had tremendous operational experience that played an integral role in growing the company. This memorial scholarship is celebrating its 18th year and was discussed with Leroy before he passed away in February 2006.

We encourage Case Farms' team members and Growers' children who plan to continue their education to apply for the J. Leroy Cook Memorial Scholarship. The scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited institution of the student's choice and any major. Awards are granted regardless of race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability or national origin.

Eligibility

- Applications will be accepted from any graduating high school senior **OR** a current university/college student planning to study in an accredited (a) four-year university OR (b) two-year college/technical school in the fall semester.
- The eligible dependent must be a child (or step-child), age 25 or under, of a **current full-time active Case Farms employee or Grower.** Dependent children are biological, step- or legally adopted children living in the employee's household or primarily supported by the employee.

Award and Payment

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive \$3,500 to attend a four-year university program or \$1,500 to attend a two-year college/technical school. The scholarship will be a "one-time" payment made directly to the College or university the student has enrolled in and will attend for the fall semester. The award is contingent upon continued parental employment at check disbursement.

Application Process

- 3. Transcript
- 4. <u>Two</u> reference applications
- 5. Proof of Dependent Relationship: Example, birth certificate or first page of last year's tax return.
- The selection committee will make the final decision on award winners.
- All documents must be received by the deadline for your application to be considered. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Questions/Answers

Q. Do I have to be accepted to the university/College before applying for the scholarship?

A. No, you do not have to be accepted to apply for the scholarship, but you must be accepted to be awarded the scholarship.

Q. How does Case Farms select scholarship recipients?

A. Case Farms is not at all involved in the selection process. The scholarship committee makes decisions on awarding scholarships based on completed application submission.

- Q. How will I find out I am selected?
- A. All scholarship winners will be notified by email

Q. How will I find out if my application was received?

A. You may email <u>casefarmsscholarship@gmail.com</u> after submitting your application to verify that it has been received. Allow some time for the application to arrive and be processed.

Q. What is the scholarship application deadline?

A. The 2024 deadline is April 12.

Q. Will my application be considered if I don't submit the requested references?

A. We must receive all requested documents of the application process to be considered for the scholarship.
